# CISCO COLLEGE ABILENE EDUCATION CENTER RESPIRATORY CARE PROGRAM Application Procedure

- 1. Obtain application forms from the school. Complete and return to the school before **June 1, 2020.**
- 2. Submit <u>official</u> high school transcript and <u>official</u> transcripts for <u>all colleges</u> or universities attended to the <u>address below</u>. A transcript from Cisco College will also be needed, if applicable. The Cisco College transcript can be printed from campus connect.
- 3. For identification purposes, bring a current driver's license or photo ID to the interview.

# 4. Submit a short paragraph answering the following questions: Explain why you want to be a respiratory therapist. What do you already know about the profession? What do you think 'excellence' is? What does quality mean to you? What are your long term goals once you acquire your A.A.S. degree. 5. Be sure that the needed references have complete addresses, including zip codes.

- 6. After submitting the application and other required information to the school, you will be contacted for any additional information that might be needed and to schedule you for your interview with the admissions committee. Interviews will begin in late June or early July.
- 7. When the applicant has submitted all necessary information and the interviews are completed, the admissions committee will select students to enter the program. Selections will be made in late June or early July and you will be notified in writing regarding the decision of the committee.

# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS RESPIRATORY CARE PROGRAM

All applicants must be 18 years of age and conform to the following admission policies. Below are the current admission requirements for 2018.

- A. STUDENTS WITH 1 29 TRANSFERABLE COLLEGE SEMESTER HOURS: Applicants with 1 – 29 transferable hours at the time of application must meet the following requirements:
  - 1. Submit official transcripts from each college or university attended. An overall grade point average of 2.25 is encouraged for admission to the Respiratory Program. You must be eligible to return to all previous institutions regardless of GPA or degree received.
  - 3. Must meet general admission requirements for Cisco College

B. STUDENTS WITH 30 OR MORE TRANSFEREABLE COLLEGE SEMESTER
 HOURS: Applicants with 30 or more transferable semester hours at the time of application must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Submit official transcripts from each college or university attended. An overall grade point average of 2.25 is encouraged for admission to the Respiratory Program. You must be eligible to return to all previous institutions regardless of GPA or degree received..
- C. All TSI developmental classes must be taken as prerequisites for the Respiratory Care Program along with:

D. Only the criteria listed are evaluated and considered for the purpose of selection and admission to this program. No specific minimum grade point average or test score, or a set minimum number of courses must be completed for admission. Selection is based on how each applicant compares with others in the applicant pool. In general, the higher the grades, the more competitive the applicant will be for the positions available.
